New Delhi: The urban development ministry on Thursday directed Delhi Development Authority (DDA) to finalise the revised Delhi Master Plan so that it can be notified by this year-end.

At the review meeting, chaired by UD secretary Shankar Aggarwal, DDA was directed to place the chapter on environmental issues in public domain by Monday for receiving suggestions and views from the public during the mandatory 45 days.
